## **Salary for Benefit Statements**

Every year MPERS issues benefit statements to our active employees. Included in the benefit statements are projected salary estimates **based on the member's pay for the month of February**. Please note that for any employee with "OHW" and flex, the salary projections may be skewed. If a member comes to you concerned about the amount shown in their statement, please keep in mind these differences and try to avoid any corrections or additions to the February payments as this may also distort their estimates.

#### **COLAs**

The annual COLA rate benefit recipients are eligible to receive for 2019 is **1.954%**. The COLA rate is based on the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (also known as the CPI-U). This rate will be used for all eligible members of the Year 2000 Plan and 2011 Tier, and members of the Closed Plan that have reached their 65% COLA cap.
