**Workplace Possibilities Program
State Group Example
Benefit Savings estimate as follows:**

Stay at Works Completed	132
Total Costs	\$363,422
Potential Liability Prevented	\$2,805,264
Adjusted ROI	4:1
Net Benefit Savings	\$1,109,341

*From 2012 through November of 2015 The Standard assisted 132 potential LTD claimants stay at work for a cost of \$363,422

An average claim prevented is valued at \$21,252 based on the group's average claim liability. The Standard potentially prevented 386 LTD claims. The potential liability prevented is \$2,805,264.

This is a potential ROI of 7.7:1.

The Standard estimates that 3 out 4 (.75) would benefit from the service and of those 70% (.70) would have become an LTD claim without WPP services. The confidence level for preventing LTD claims is .525 (.70 * .75).

The adjusted ROI is 4:1 = a net savings of \$1,109,341.
